The first Radical Collaboration Best Practices Meeting in Cuernavaca, Mexico, was a great success. As a result, The Human Element Sweden and The RC Group will be hosting the second Radical Collaboration Best Practices Meeting in Stockholm on August 22–23, 2016.



### TIME AND VENUE

The meeting will start at 9 am on Monday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> and will end at 5 pm on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. The workshop is set to take place at Bommersvik Conference Center, Bommersvik, Järna. The workshop is open to all Radical Collaboration Certified Trainers.

### PROGRAM

The purpose of this gathering is for us to share with each other strategies and tactics that have helped us spread RC throughout the world.

*The program include sessions such as:*

- What's new in RC (Revised FIRO Module, Pink Zone, Three Perspectives Exercise, etc.)
- Successful RC marketing tools
- RC success stories
- 7 minute updates (for anyone wishing to share what they are doing with RC)
- A preview of the new RC based Green Zone Culture Leadership Program (three sessions over a six month period with on-going assignments in between each session) which will only be available to certified RC trainers.

All attendees are also invited to experience the new Radical Collaboration Competencies report that has just been released. The RCC report is a joint project between RC and Harrison Assessments. All attendees will be invited to take the assessment, receive their own feedback report, and attend a 3 hour certification module at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> day (23<sup>rd</sup>).

### PRICE

The tuition for this meeting will be 2 500 SEK. Full board and lodging in single-bed rooms: 2 530 SEK.
